

Love Outpoured

Sometimes we may not know the best way to show love to others or even how we can be loving in a particular situation. Proverbs 17:17 says that a "friend loves at all times." We should love others, not only during good times, but always. Here are a few ways to love at all times:

1. Carry Each Other's Burdens

Carrying each other's burdens might not look the same in every situation. Some people might just want a listening ear. Others might need physical help, such as help with yard work or cleaning. Still others might just want to know someone is there for them if they need it.

2. Be Present in Rejoicing and Mourning

Often, in order to love people, we must be present in what they are experiencing, whether it be joy or hardship. Romans 12:15 says, "Rejoice with those who rejoice."
