The Gospel is For All

“But everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”
Acts 2:21

Did you know that there is no-one too far out of the reach of the grace of Almighty God. His love reaches beyond our understanding, and His measure for who deserves His love and who doesn't, goes far beyond our human limitations. In fact God wants all men and women everywhere to be saved. That is why it says in His word that 'all who call on the name of the Lord will be saved.' That includes everyone. No matter where you are from, your gender, social class, age or the like, no-one is excluded from God's love. This was demonstrated on the day of Pentecost when the Holy Spirit was poured out among the disciples and apostles. The writer of Acts goes into great detail, naming each province or area's language that was being supernaturally spoken by those who had been filled with the Holy Spirit. The writer could have easily skipped this point, but he chose to leave this important information in, to highlight the fact that God wanted and wants to reach all people with His truth, irrespective of your nationality and so on. God's love is for all people, everywhere.

So what does “calls on the Lord” look like. If we read just a little further in the text it tells us the people when hearing Peters sermon were “cut to the heart” and asked what to do. Peter replied in verse 38 to “repent and be baptized, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Everyone from all walks of life and all parts of the world are given the same opportunity. Gods love and desire for all men to come to him is not limited to a gender, social status or race. All means all. This make all who do brothers and sisters through Christ sacrifice.
