Armor of God

Paul's metaphor is quite colorful and vivid (vv. 14–17). Truth is a "belt" that holds together all the rest. Righteousness is a protective "breastplate" (see Isa. 59:17) and salvation is a protective "helmet." The soldier's shoes or boots are a readiness to stand on and proclaim the gospel of peace (Rom. 5:1). Faith is a "shield" that extinguishes the "flaming arrows" of Satan (see also 1 Peter 1:5). Finally, there is "the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God" (see also Rev. 1:16).

What does it mean to “put on” this armor? Note that we don’t manufacture any of it—it’s all from God. He helps us choose to make it part of our spiritual lives. Putting it on, then, involves making choices, forming habits, and cultivating virtues.

Hebrews 13:15

Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually
offer to God a sacrifice of praise—
the fruit of lips that openly profess His name.
