

Fully Rely On God

Reliance and relationship. The Bible tells us on our faith walk we cannot have one without the other.

King David, the mighty warrior and king, begins his most famous psalm by affirming his reliance on the Lord as the cornerstone of their relationship. Notice how David acknowledges the role of the Lord. "He makes me, he leads me, he guides me, he refreshes me." He then switches his prose to address the Lord directly. "You are with me, you comfort me, you prepare a table for me, you anoint my head with oil."

It appears David learned most of his relationship lessons the hard way. Psalms 25 and 26, among many others, record his response to many trials and challenges. He learned to rely on the Lord when times were tough. Isn't that the way it is with us?

When we stumble and fall, not only is God there to pick us up, but He usually makes sure we learn a lesson or two along the way...if we are willing to listen.
